



The relative strengths and weaknesses of DANA Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DANA Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of DANA Inc is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 104%, being 0.74% points above the market average of 103%.
