



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tesla Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tesla Inc compared to the market average is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 24% points. The greatest weakness of Tesla Inc is the variable Liabilities, Noncurrent, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 87%, being 16% points below the market average of 103%.
