United Airlines Holdings Inc Rank 14 of 19



The relative strengths and weaknesses of United Airlines Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United Airlines Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points. The greatest weakness of United Airlines Holdings Inc is the variable Other Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 18% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 56%, being 20% points below the market average of 77%.
