

## American Airlines Group Inc Rank 10 of 18

The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Airlines Group Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Airlines Group Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 56% points. The greatest weakness of American Airlines Group Inc is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 85% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 70%, being 4.0% points below the market average of 74%.
