

## Southwest Airlines CO Rank 7 of 18



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Southwest Airlines CO are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Southwest Airlines CO compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points. The greatest weakness of Southwest Airlines CO is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 93%, being 19% points above the market average of 74%.
