

United Airlines Holdings Inc Rank 11 of 17

The relative strengths and weaknesses of United Airlines Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United Airlines Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 32% points. The greatest weakness of United Airlines Holdings Inc is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 61%, being 8.5% points below the market average of 69%.
