



The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Airlines Group Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Airlines Group Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 3.6% points. The greatest weakness of American Airlines Group Inc is the variable Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 34%, being 44% points below the market average of 78%.
