



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Delta AIR Lines INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Delta AIR Lines INC compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Noncurrent, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of Delta AIR Lines INC is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 30%, being 37% points below the market average of 67%.
