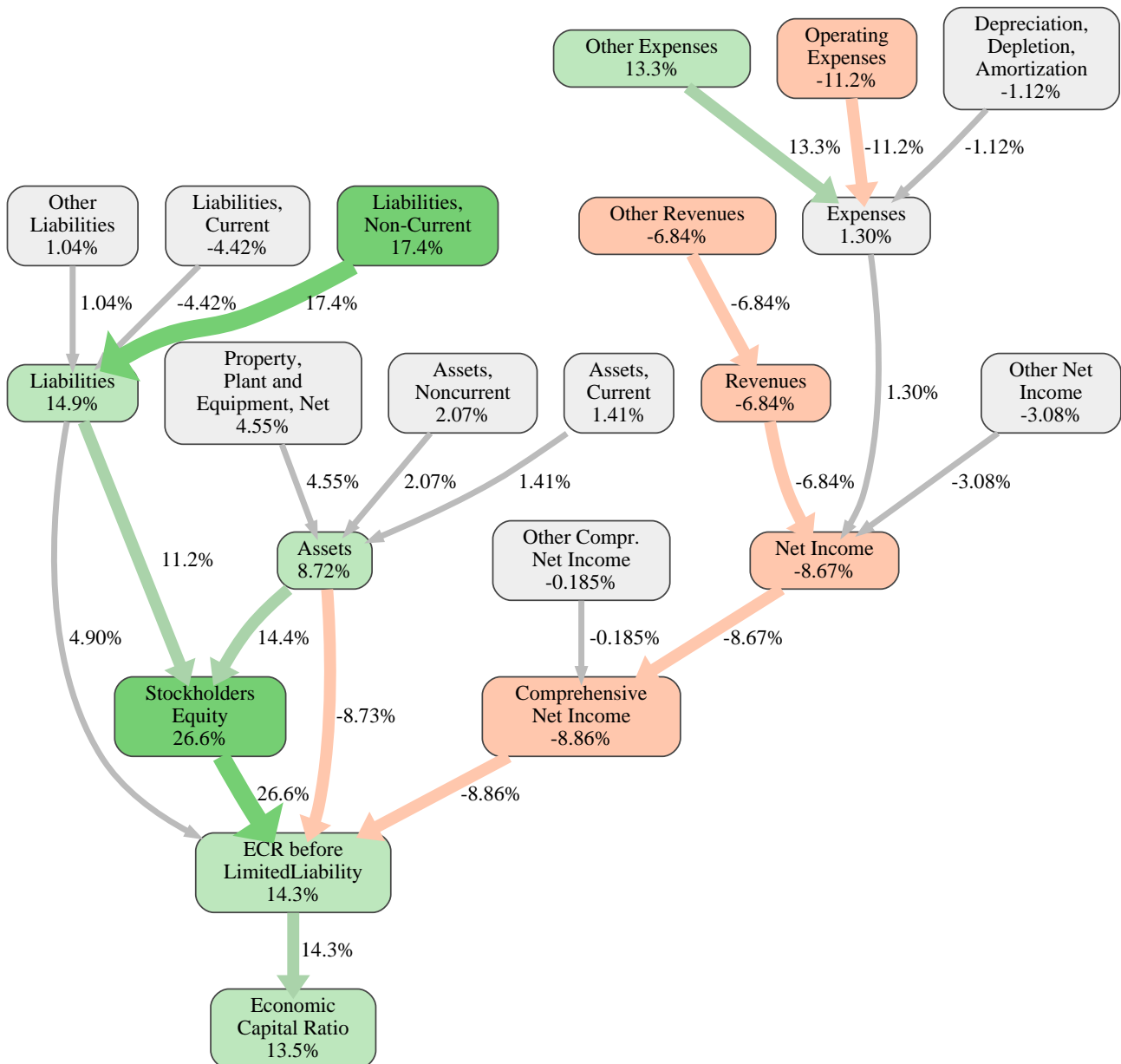

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of United Airlines Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United Airlines Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points. The greatest weakness of United Airlines Holdings Inc is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 11% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 80%, being 13% points above the market average of 67%.
