



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sterling Infrastructure Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sterling Infrastructure Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of Sterling Infrastructure Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 88%, being 36% points below the market average of 125%.
