



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intralinks Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intralinks Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 254% points. The greatest weakness of Intralinks Holdings Inc is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 558%, being 219% points above the market average of 339%.
