The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intuit INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intuit INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 154% points. The greatest weakness of Intuit INC is the variable Selling and Marketing Exp., reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 465%, being 133% points above the market average of 332%.
