

Pioneer Natural Resources Co Rank 5 of 40

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Pioneer Natural Resources Co are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Pioneer Natural Resources Co compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 80% points. The greatest weakness of Pioneer Natural Resources Co is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 8.7% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 226%, being 85% points above the market average of 141%.
