

Bakken Resources INC Rank 90 of 191

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Bakken Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Bakken Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 50% points. The greatest weakness of Bakken Resources INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 64% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 85%, being 23% points below the market average of 108%.
