

The relative strengths and weaknesses of RED Mountain Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of RED Mountain Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of RED Mountain Resources INC is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 46% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 60%, being 48% points below the market average of 108%.
