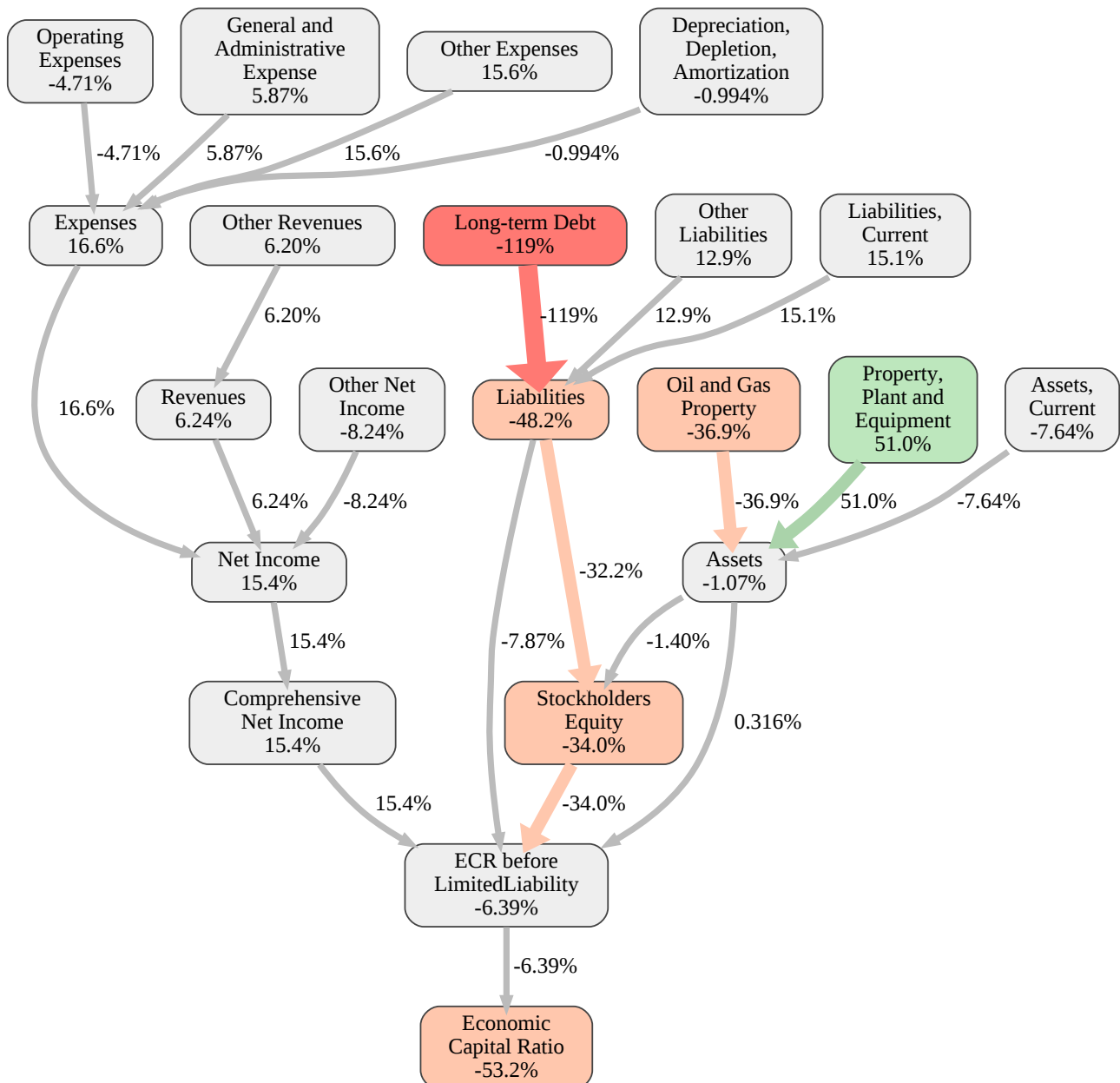

QR Energy LP Rank 112 of 174

The relative strengths and weaknesses of QR Energy LP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of QR Energy LP compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points. The greatest weakness of QR Energy LP is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 119% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 63%, being 53% points below the market average of 117%.
