


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








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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Southwestern Energy CO are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Southwestern Energy CO compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points. The greatest weakness of Southwestern Energy CO is the variable Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 57% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 61%, being 42% points below the market average of 103%.
