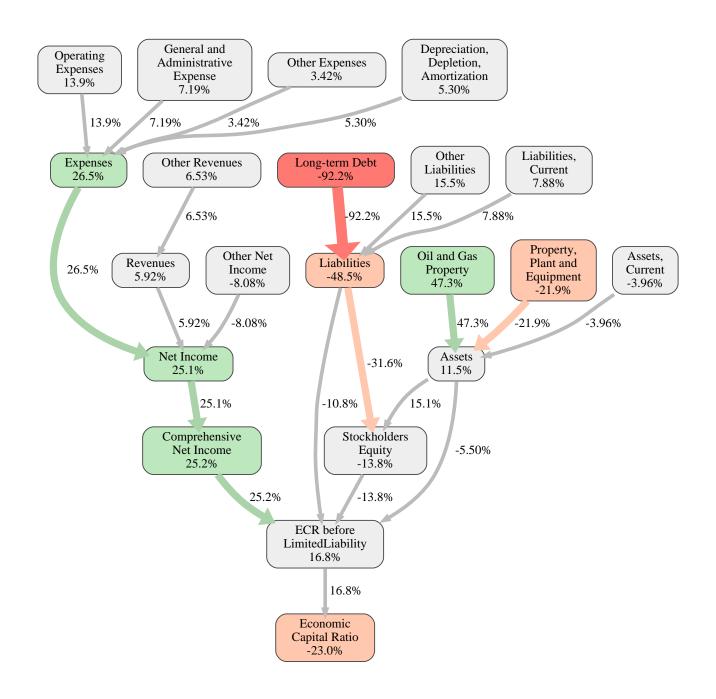


PETROLEUM 2015



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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sandridge Energy INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sandridge Energy INC compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 47% points. The greatest weakness of Sandridge Energy INC is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 92% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 80%, being 23% points below the market average of 103%.
