

## Texas South Energy Inc Rank 40 of 171



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Texas South Energy Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Texas South Energy Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 171% points. The greatest weakness of Texas South Energy Inc is the variable General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 26% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 175%, being 72% points above the market average of 103%.
