

## Breitburn Energy Partners LP Rank 81 of 118

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Breitburn Energy Partners LP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Breitburn Energy Partners LP compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points. The greatest weakness of Breitburn Energy Partners LP is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 47% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 20%, being 74% points below the market average of 94%.
