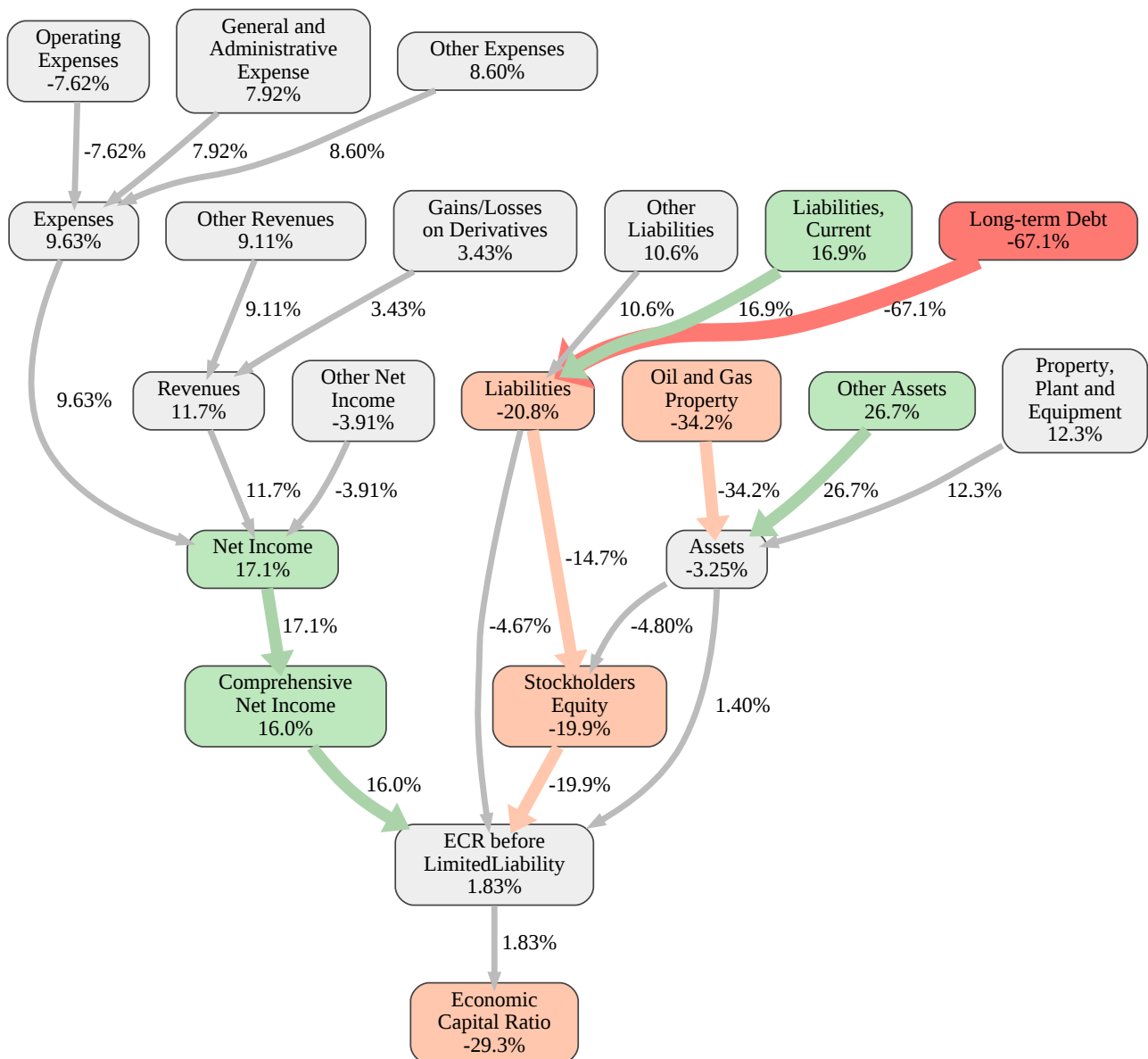




The relative strengths and weaknesses of Encana CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Encana CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points. The greatest weakness of Encana CORP is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 79%, being 29% points below the market average of 108%.
