

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sandridge Energy INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sandridge Energy INC compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 4.2% points. The greatest weakness of Sandridge Energy INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 5.3%, being 74% points below the market average of 80%.
