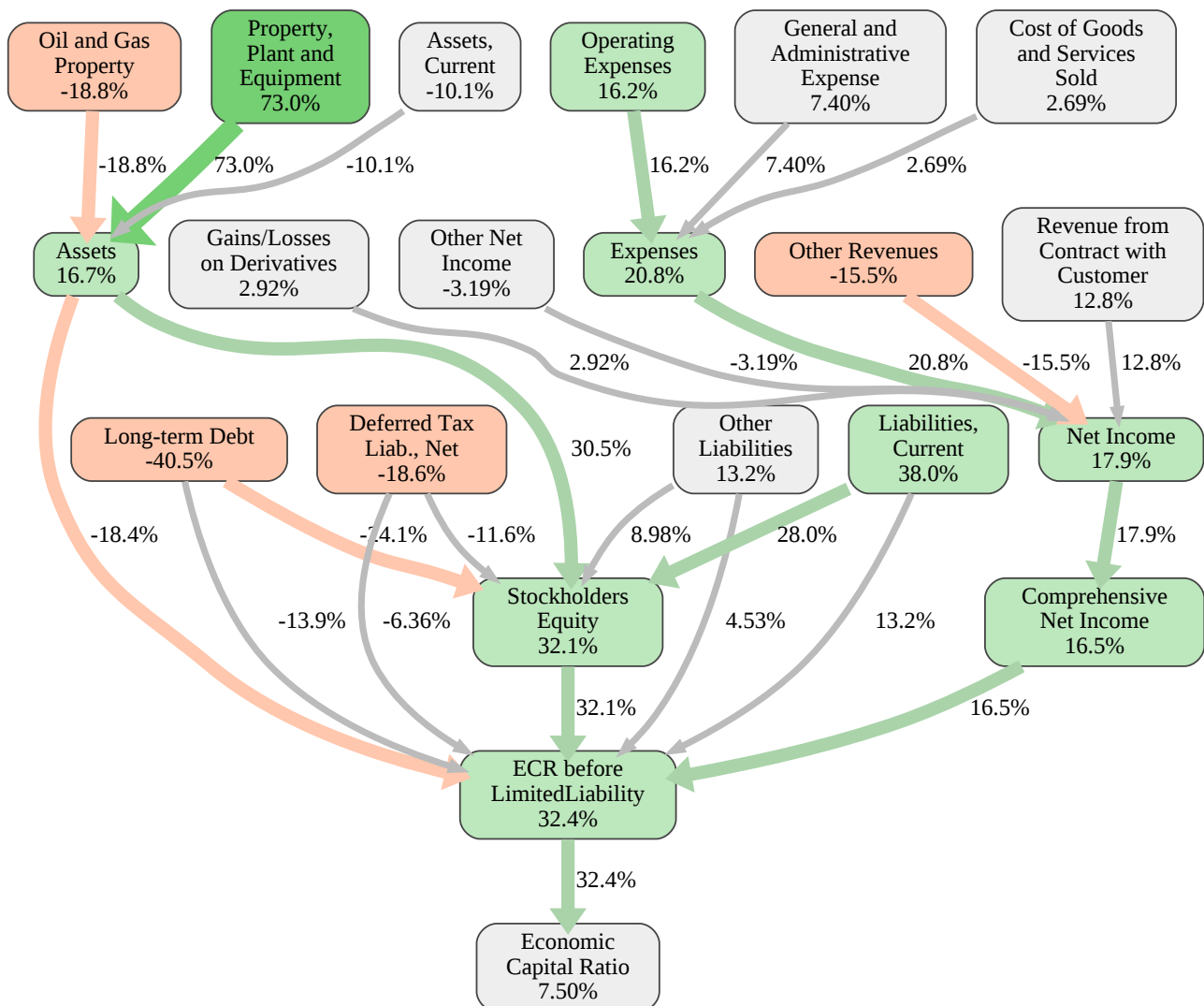




The relative strengths and weaknesses of Diamondback Energy Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Diamondback Energy Inc compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 73% points. The greatest weakness of Diamondback Energy Inc is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 41% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 132%, being 7.5% points above the market average of 124%.
