





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Bloomia Holdings INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Bloomia Holdings INC compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 59% points. The greatest weakness of Bloomia Holdings INC is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 30% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 167%, being 75% points above the market average of 92%.
