



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Frontier Funds are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Frontier Funds compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points. The greatest weakness of Frontier Funds is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 9.7% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 200%, being 55% points above the market average of 145%.
