

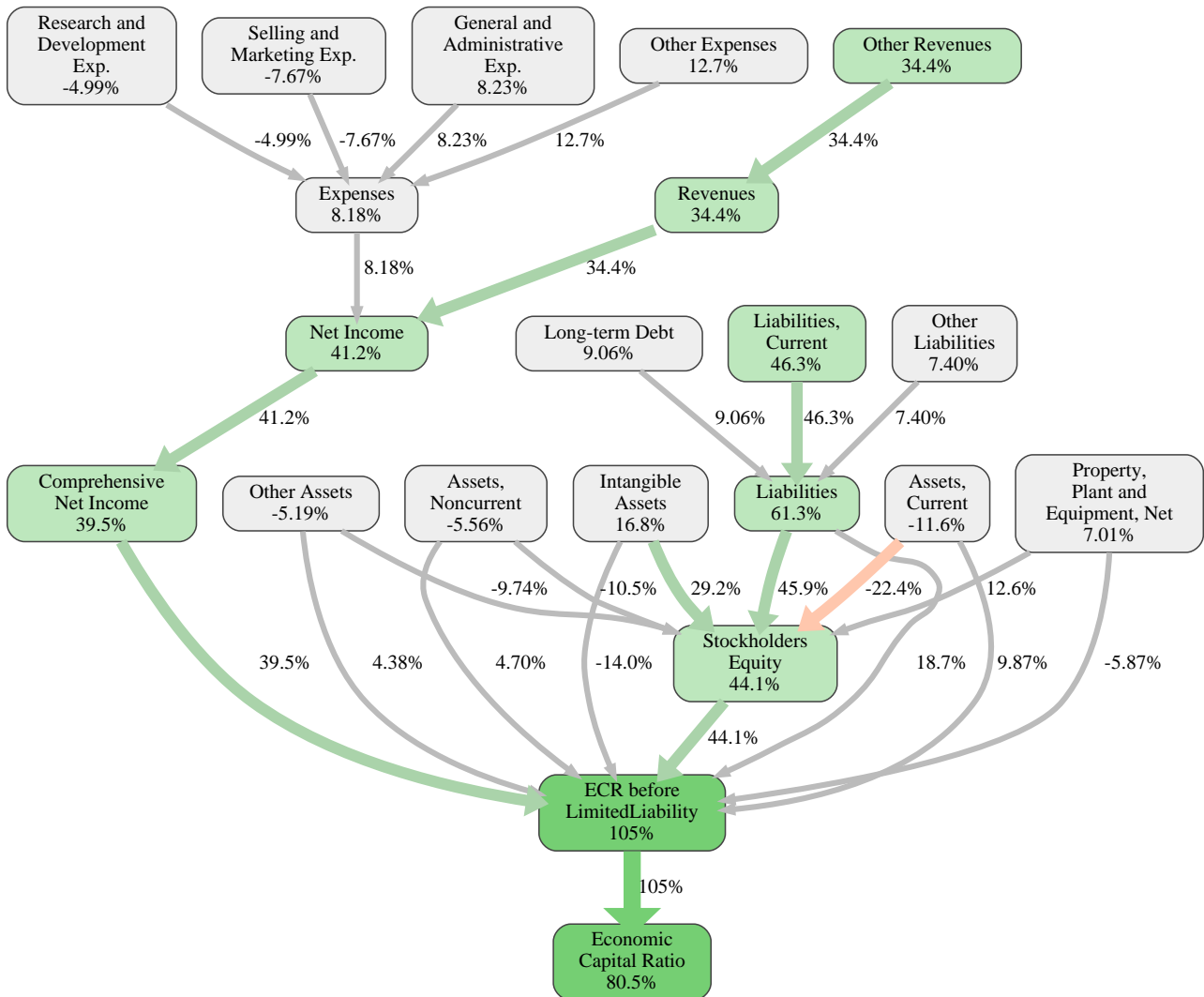


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Intuit INC Rank 46 of 148





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Intuit INC
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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intuit INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intuit INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 61% points. The greatest weakness of Intuit INC is the variable Assets, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 455%, being 80% points above the market average of 375%.
