

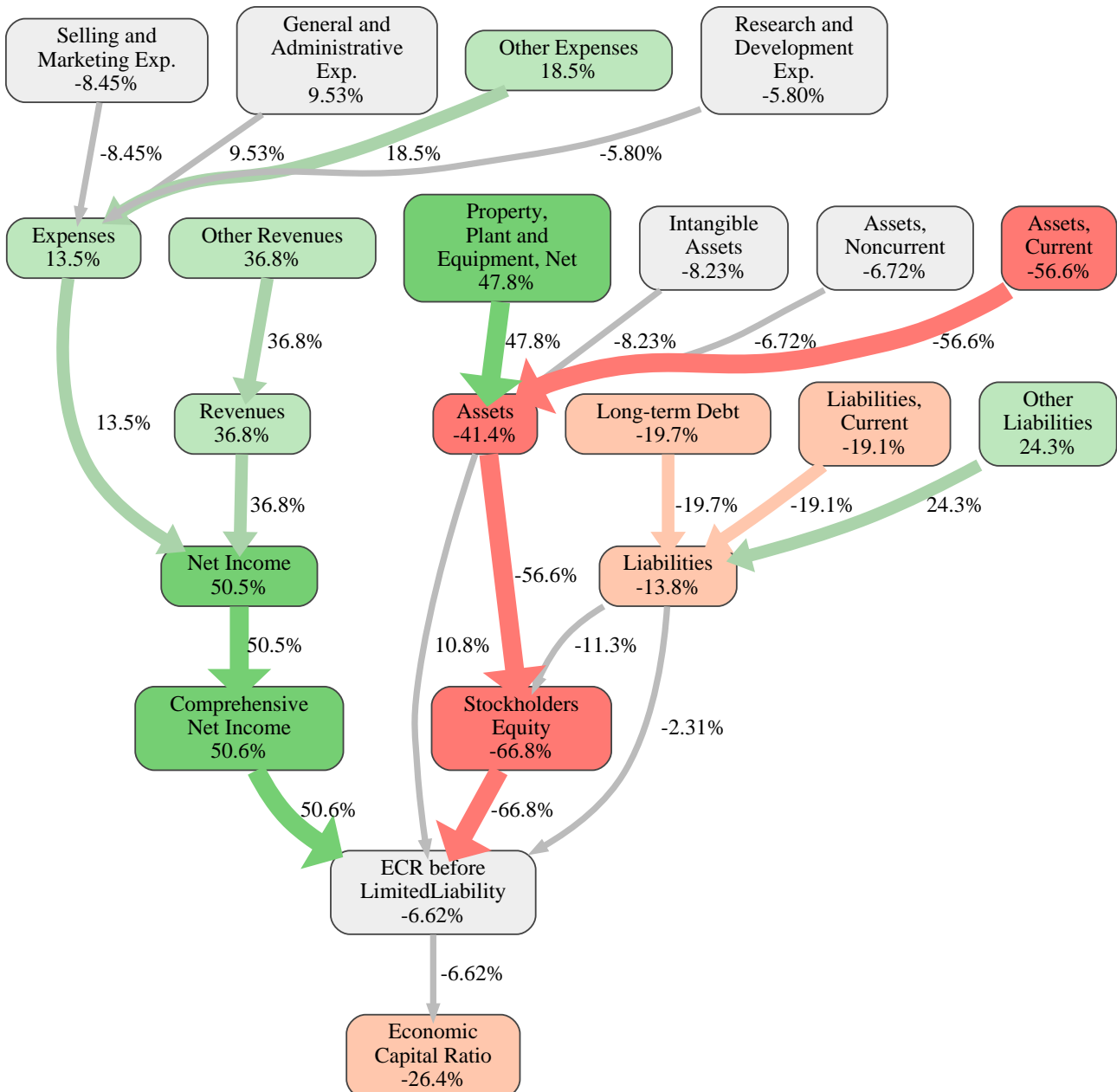

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intuit INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intuit INC compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points. The greatest weakness of Intuit INC is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 331%, being 26% points below the market average of 357%.
