



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Fortinet Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Fortinet Inc compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 112% points. The greatest weakness of Fortinet Inc is the variable Administrative and Marketing Exp., reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 52% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 290%, being 57% points above the market average of 233%.
