





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Netcapital Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Netcapital Inc compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points. The greatest weakness of Netcapital Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 45% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 52%, being 39% points below the market average of 91%.
