



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tyson Foods INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tyson Foods INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 73% points. The greatest weakness of Tyson Foods INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 109% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 197%, being 23% points above the market average of 175%.
