The relative strengths and weaknesses of Baytex Energy USA INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Baytex Energy USA INC compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points. The greatest weakness of Baytex Energy USA INC is the variable Depreciation, Depletion, Amortization, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 212%, being 102% points above the market average of 110%.
