



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Apache CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Apache CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 108% points. The greatest weakness of Apache CORP is the variable Depreciation, Depletion, Amortization, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 26% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 203%, being 97% points above the market average of 106%.
