



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Chaparral Energy Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Chaparral Energy Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 94% points. The greatest weakness of Chaparral Energy Inc is the variable Depreciation, Depletion, Amortization, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 8.3% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 213%, being 107% points above the market average of 106%.
