





The relative strengths and weaknesses of BLUE Dolphin Energy CO are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of BLUE Dolphin Energy CO compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 427% points. The greatest weakness of BLUE Dolphin Energy CO is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 256% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 443%, being 323% points above the market average of 120%.
