## Energy 11 L P Rank 19 of 98

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Energy 11 L P are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Energy 11 L P compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 106% points. The greatest weakness of Energy 11 L P is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 196%, being 89% points above the market average of 107%.
