The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intermec Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intermec Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 185% points. The greatest weakness of Intermec Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 837% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 192%, being 29% points below the market average of 221%.
