





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Interlink Electronics Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Interlink Electronics Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 382% points. The greatest weakness of Interlink Electronics Inc is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 237% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 564%, being 331% points above the market average of 233%.
