



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Keurig Green Mountain INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Keurig Green Mountain INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points. The greatest weakness of Keurig Green Mountain INC is the variable Selling and Marketing Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 207%, being 37% points above the market average of 170%.
