### US Airways Group INC Rank 17 of 18

The relative strengths and weaknesses of US Airways Group INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of US Airways Group INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 10.0% points. The greatest weakness of US Airways Group INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 36%, being 41% points below the market average of 77%.
