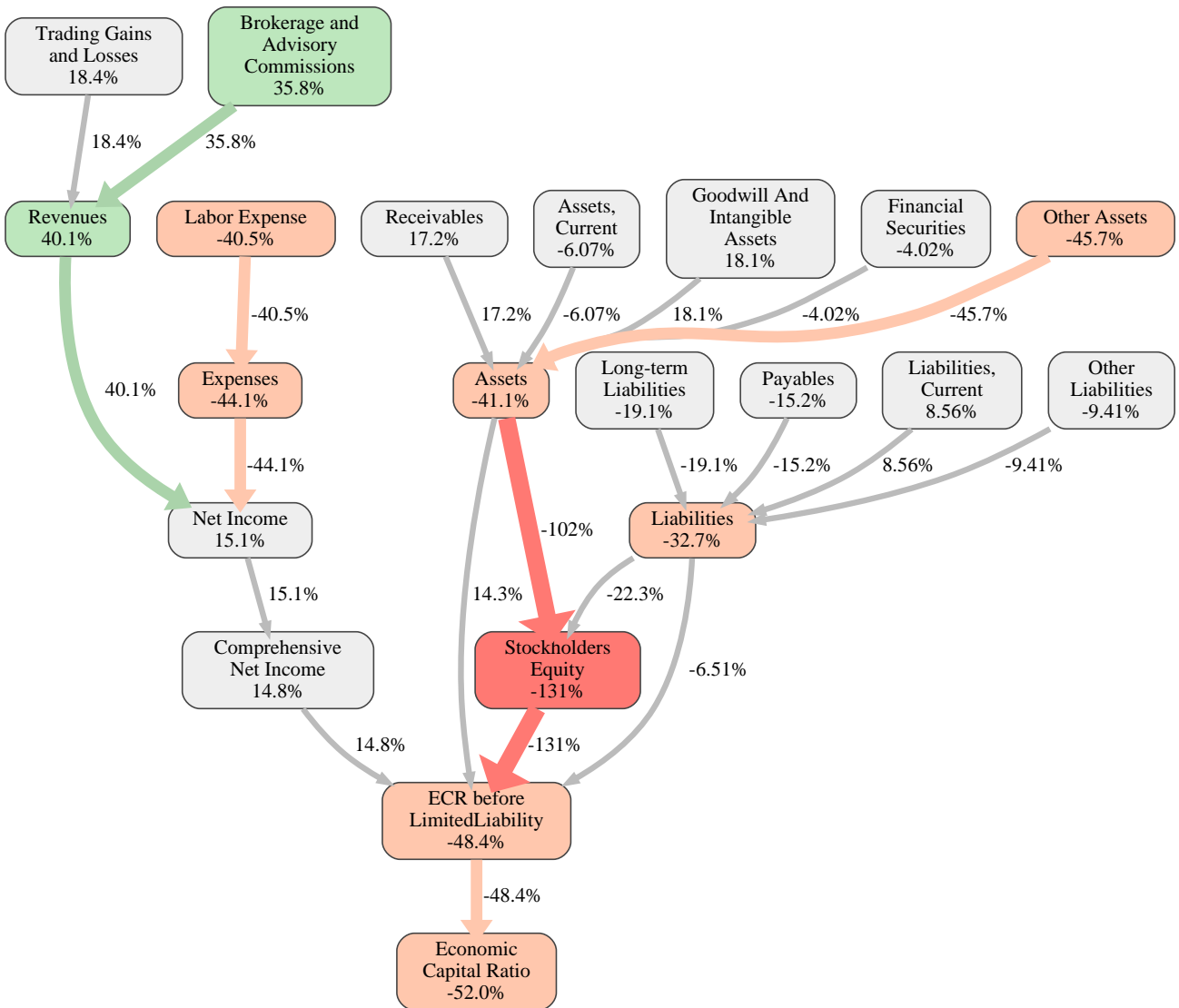




BROKERS 2012

GFI Group Inc
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The relative strengths and weaknesses of GFI Group Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GFI Group Inc compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of GFI Group Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 131% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 82%, being 52% points below the market average of 134%.
