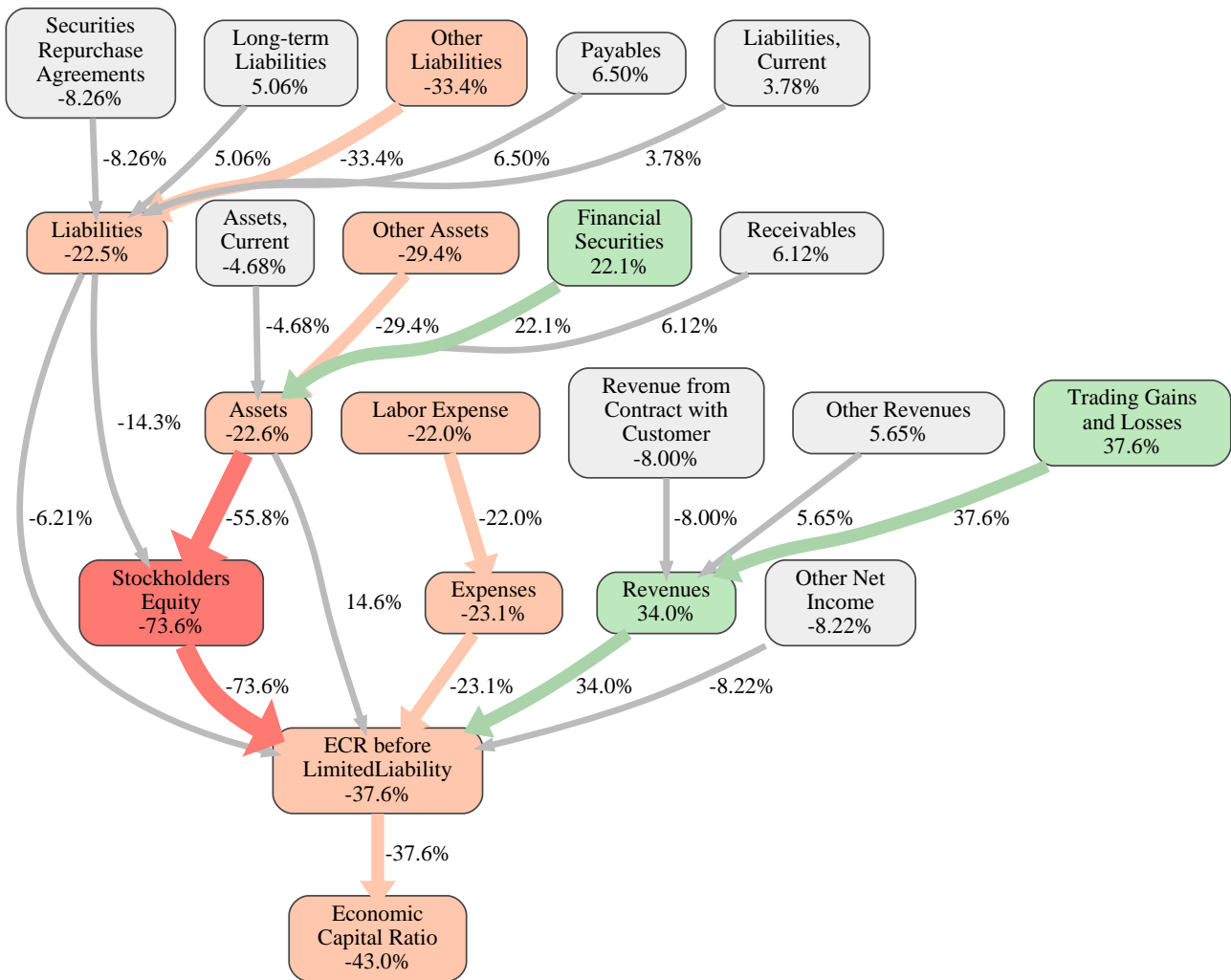

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Piper Sandler Companies are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Piper Sandler Companies compared to the market average is the variable Trading Gains and Losses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 38% points. The greatest weakness of Piper Sandler Companies is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 74% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 101%, being 43% points below the market average of 144%.
