



The relative strengths and weaknesses of World Gold Trust are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of World Gold Trust compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 69% points. The greatest weakness of World Gold Trust is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 230%, being 91% points above the market average of 138%.
