



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Blackstone Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Blackstone Inc compared to the market average is the variable Investment Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 45% points. The greatest weakness of Blackstone Inc is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 102%, being 18% points above the market average of 83%.
