



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Wilhelmina International Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Wilhelmina International Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 58% points. The greatest weakness of Wilhelmina International Inc is the variable Labor Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 187%, being 58% points above the market average of 129%.
