The relative strengths and weaknesses of Mainland Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Mainland Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 94% points. The greatest weakness of Mainland Resources INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 53% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 151%, being 59% points above the market average of 92%.
