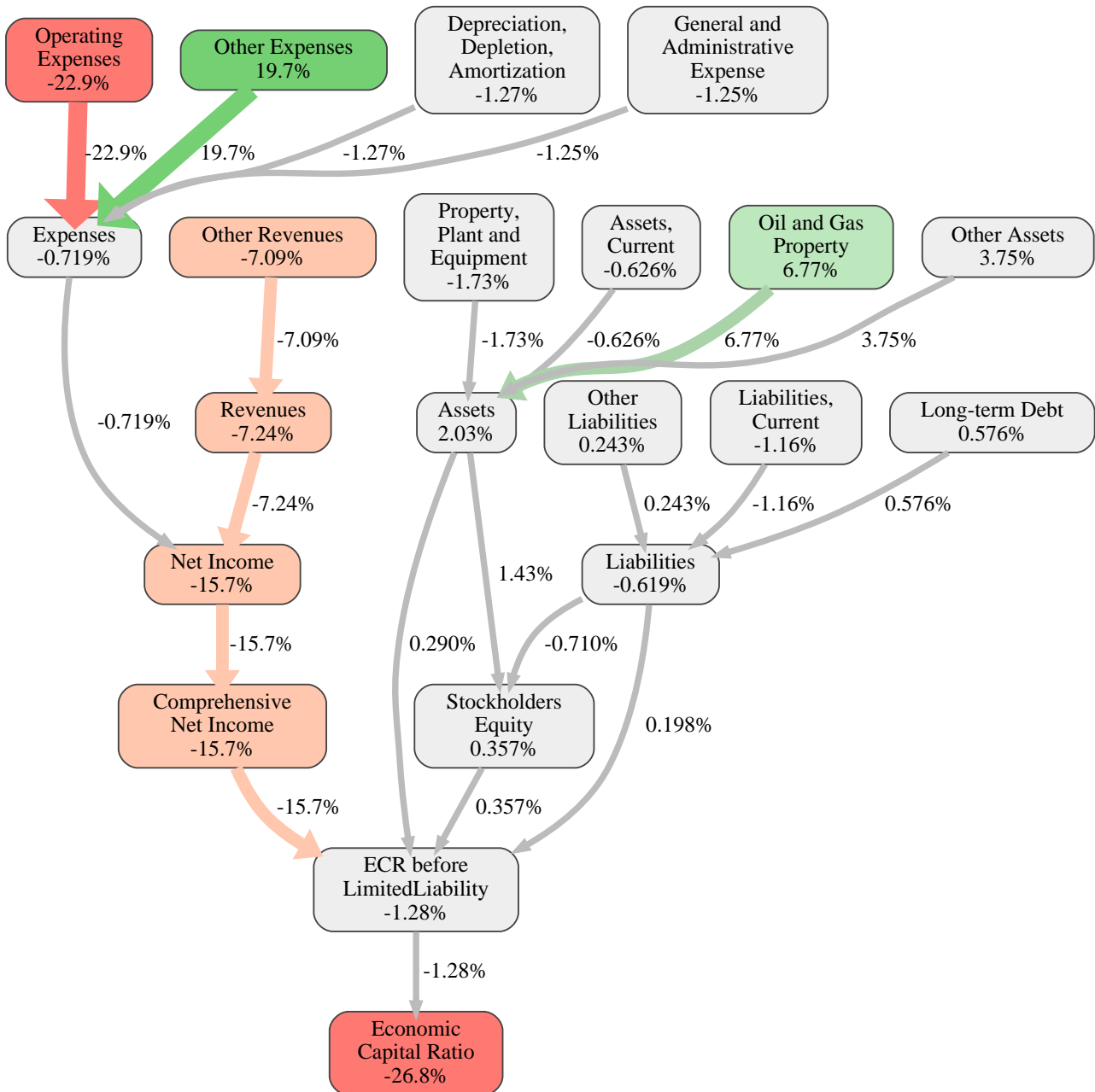




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RED Mountain Resources INC Rank 140 of 189





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of RED Mountain Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of RED Mountain Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points. The greatest weakness of RED Mountain Resources INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 53%, being 27% points below the market average of 80%.
