The relative strengths and weaknesses of Armada Oil Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Armada Oil Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points. The greatest weakness of Armada Oil Inc is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 57% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 53%, being 33% points below the market average of 86%.
