Trans Energy INC Rank 61 of 138

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Trans Energy INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Trans Energy INC compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of Trans Energy INC is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 19% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 50%, being 4.5% points above the market average of 46%.
