



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Diamondback Energy Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Diamondback Energy Inc compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points. The greatest weakness of Diamondback Energy Inc is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 43% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 75%, being 29% points above the market average of 46%.
