The relative strengths and weaknesses of Noble Energy INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Noble Energy INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points. The greatest weakness of Noble Energy INC is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 75%, being 2.1% points above the market average of 73%.
